



AADOCR and Friends of NIDCR 2022 Advocacy Day: Organization Asks

The American Association for Dental, Oral, and Craniofacial Research (AADOCR) and the Friends of National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research (FNIDCR) urge Congress to prioritize funding for the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research (NIDCR), the National Institutes of Health (NIH), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Division of Oral Health, and to establish and fund the Advanced Research Projects Agency for Health (ARPA-H) in fiscal year 2023.

We have five "asks" for Members of Congress:

- 1. Pass the FY 2022 omnibus spending package with robust increases for NIH and NIDCR.
- 2. Support a funding level of \$558 million for NIDCR in FY 2023.
- 3. Support a funding level of at least \$50 billion for NIH in FY 2023.
- 4. Support a funding level of \$35 million for CDC's Division of Oral Health in FY 2023.
- 5. Cosponsor H.R. 5585, the ARPA-H Act, or other legislation that authorizes and funds ARPA-H.

The research and oral health programs supported by these federal agencies and the proposed ARPA-H enhance the knowledge base of health professionals, researchers, and policymakers with the goal of improving dental clinical practices, closing the gap in dental health disparities, and addressing public health challenges, including COVID-19, opioid use and pain, temporomandibular joint disorders (TMJDs), rising e-cigarette use among teens and young adults, and human papillomavirus (HPV)-positive oral cancers.
