



AADR and Friends of NIDCR 2021 Capitol Hill Day: Fiscal Year 2022 Funding Requests

The American Association for Dental Research (AADR) and the Friends of National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research (FNIDCR) urge Congress to prioritize funding for the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research (NIDCR), the National Institutes of Health (NIH), the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Division of Oral Health, and the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) in fiscal year 2022.

We have four "asks" for Members of Congress:

- 1. Support a funding level of \$520 million for NIDCR.
- 2. Support a funding level of \$46.111 billion for NIH.
- 3. Support a funding level of \$29 million for CDC's Division of Oral Health.
- 4. Support a funding level of \$46 million for the Title VII Oral Health Training Programs within HRSA, with a \$14 million set-aside for the General & Pediatric Residencies.

The research and oral health programs supported by these federal agencies enhance the knowledge base used to inform policy, improve dental clinical practices and help eliminate disparities in access to dental care, leading to better overall health and well-being.
